INTRODUCTION

Clinical research increasingly depends on quantification of risks, diagnosis and therapy. Knowledge of principles and techniques of the quantitative approach used in clinical medicine is indispensable for effective clinical research. This course will focus on the methodology of quantitative clinical research, including therapeutic and drug research. Some topics in evidence-based medicine will also be addressed.

This course will be conducted by EBM unit, IMR and Institute for Health Management, MOH in collaboration with Department of Social and Preventive Medicine, University of Malaya and University Medical Centre Utrecht, Netherlands.
