RURAL HEALTH

When Malaya obtained her Independence in 1957, medical and health became a Federal Subject and the administration of these services passed from the hands of State Governments to the Central Government. The Central Government inherited a medical and health service which was unevenly distributed not only between States but between areas within a State. As a result of this, more than 70% of the services were concentrated in the Urban and Semi-Urban areas where about 40% of the population lived and the remaining 60% of the population, mainly living in rural areas, were provided with the remainder of the service. It was therefore an uncommon feature to find that many rural villages and kampongs had little or no medical and health service.

However, in the social and economic development plans of Government, after Merdeka, top priority was given to the expansion and development of adequate medical, health and dental services for the rural population. The primary aim of Government was and still is, to raise the health standard of the rural people so that their economic productivity will be increased. Loss of lives and absence from work due to ill-health brings with it economic loss not only to the family itself but to the country as well. Poverty can be the direct cause of ill-health and in turn could influence the incidence of diseases and mal-nutrition. Hence a vigorous attack on conditions undermining health is fundamental in breaking this vicious cycle of illness and poverty.

In order to overcome the problem of rural ill-health within the shortest possible time, the Rural Health Service was conceived with the assistance of the World Health Organisation. The objectives of the Rural Health Service are not merely to reduce the number of deaths and the incidence of diseases, but to take it a step further, in the attainment of optimum health for all our people. If maximum benefits are to be derived from the efforts of Government to raise the standard of living and health of our people, it is fundamental that the people must be aware of the fact that ill-health causes poverty. They must therefore take appropriate measures to safe-guard their health and participate actively in all the health programmes and extend their co-operation to the health authorities.

Rural Health Service

In conceiving the Rural Health Service, consideration was given to the provision of an integrated curative and preventive service for the rural people, based on their needs and problems and on the pre-existing medical or health service prior to the inception of the Rural Health Service. All pre-existing facilities in an area are being co-ordinated and integrated, by using the Rural Health Unit as a base or functional organisation for the operation of the Rural Health Service.

The basic plan called for:

- (a) trained rural midwives, one per 2,000 population;
- (b) one health sub-centre for every 10,000 population; and
- (c) a main centre for every 50,000 population.

Hence for every 50,000 rural population, the Rural Health Unit will comprise of 1 Main Centre, 4 Health Sub-Centres and 20 Midwife Clinics-cum-quarters (each main and sub-centre has a midwife and there are therefore 25 midwives for the given population)—See Appendix I.

The staffing pattern of a Rural Health Unit is as follows:

From the above, it can be concluded that, although progress in physical construction was slow in the First Malaya Plan, this had picked up in the Second Malaya Plan; and that in the First Malaysia Plan the gains had been consolidated so that progress had been maintained in the face of an expanding population. However, the target of 1 rural health unit for every 50,000 rural population has not yet been achieved.

In the meantime the Planning and Research Division of the Ministry is carrying out an assessment of the Rural Health Service through an Operations Research Team staffed by WHO experts and their national counterparts. The study is made up of two parts—the service study and the community study. The result of this

study will provide useful information on the utilization-pattern of the service by the community, the degree the service has satisfied the needs and demands of the rural population and its effectiveness and efficacy in reducing health problems.

The result of this study is expected in mid-1972, when a thorough review of the service will be made with a view to modifying the service so that it would function at its optimum efficiency.

Mortality Rates as Indicators of Progress

Appendix II show the vital statistical rates from 1946-1968 pertaining to the fall in mortality rates in West Malaysia. No breakdown figures are available for rural and urban areas. However, the more rapid rate of fall of infant mortality rates of Malays as compared to the other Ethnic Groups, particularly since 1957, is indicative of the improved health and socio-economic conditions in the rural areas. (See Appendix III).

2nd Malaysia Plan: (1971-1975)

Continued emphasis will be placed on the expansion of the Rural Health Service in the 2nd Malaysia Plan (1971-1975). A sum of \$30 million has been sought for this purpose. It is proposed to build the following units during 1971-1975—

- 15 Main Health Centres;
- 56 Health Sub-Centres; and
- 245 Midwives Clinics-cum-Quarters.

Other National Public Health Programmes

The Ministry of Health has launched a number of Public Health Programmes on a national basis. These programmes cut-across State and other boundaries and cover both the urban and rural population. These programmes are—

- (a) *The Yaws Elimination Programme* which has been most successful and a case of yaws in the riverine rural areas is now an exception rather than a rule. There is every indication that this disease, which was once a scourge of the riverine areas, will be totally eradicated from this country in due course.
- (b) *Tuberculosis*—The National Tuberculosis Control Programme which commenced in 1961 is now fully operational. 60 Chest Clinics with ward facilities have been established throughout the country.

The components of the Control Programme are—

- (i) *The Training Programme* aims at training different categories of technical personnel sufficient in numbers for the country-wide control campaign has progressed satisfactorily and some 2,481 personnel have been trained.
- (ii) *The B.C.G. Vaccination Programme* aims at protecting the susceptible members of the population against tuberculosis has topped the 3 million mark by the end of 1970.
- (iii) *The Case-finding Drive* using mass miniature X-ray units followed by bacteriological examination of sputum of cases showing X-ray abnormalities on a routine basis is being progressively reduced and greater emphasis is being placed on bacteriological examination of sputum of suspected cases of tuberculosis.

There are definite indications that the incidence of tuberculosis is on a downward trend. The infection rate in the child population has been halved, and so has the incidence of the disease.

A tuberculosis prevalence survey was launched in May 1970 and was conducted in 72 randomly selected population clusters distributed all over West Malaysia. Each cluster comprised 75 households or approximately 350 people. Each Survey Team was composed of—

- (i) A registration sub-team;
- (ii) An examination sub-team; and
- (iii) A follow-up team.

This survey was completed recently and the final results will be available in April, 1971.

This survey is also tied up with the move to structure and fully integrate the Tuberculosis Control Programme with the basic health services in areas where the disease has ceased to be a public health problem.

- (c) *Malaria*—The Malaria Eradication Programme in West Malaysia is directed by the Division of Malaria at the Ministry of Health. A State Malaria Eradication Office, one in each State, will be established. This Office will be headed by a State Malariologist who receives overall administrative supervision from the Chief Medical and Health Officer, and technical operational directions and supervision from MEP Headquarters at the Ministry of Health. The State Malariologist supervises all the District Malaria Eradication Offices. Each District is sub-divided into Sectors, each with a population of 40,000-50,000. Six State Malaria Eradication Offices have been established in Perlis, Kedah, Penang, Perak, Kelantan and Trengganu. Another will be established in Pahang in 1971.

The "1st Stage" of the operation covered 5 Districts with a population of 701,805 in Perlis, Kedah and Penang States. The 1st cycle of spraying started on 11 July, 1968 and was completed by 28 February, 1969. The 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th cycles of spraying have been completed by the end of 1970. In 1971 they will enter into the 6th and 7th cycles.

Geographical reconnaissance in all 11 Districts of the "2nd Stage" operational areas in Kedah and Penang States covering a population of 1,104,886 was completed by January 1969. Spraying operations in this area has now reached the 4th cycle and by the end of 1971 the 5th spraying cycle is expected to be completed.

The geographical reconnaissance in the "3rd Stage" area of the six Districts in Northern Perak and Kelantan with a population of 364,822 which started in August 1969 has been completed. By the end of 1970 the 1st spraying cycle has also been completed. In 1971 two more cycles of spraying operations are expected to be carried out.

The "4th Stage" area includes Central Perak, Southern Kelantan and the whole of Trengganu comprising 30 sectors and a total population of 1,724,241, and geographical reconnaissance started in July 1970 and is expected to be completed by the end of April, 1971. The 1st spraying cycle in this "Stage" will commence in July 1971.

The "5th Stage" area comprising of the remainder of Perak and the whole of Pahang State will come under the "preparatory phase" this year (1971).


By the end of 1971 more than 50% of the population of this country will be protected from Malaria.

(d) *Filariasis*—This is a long-term programme involving population group living in remote areas. Regular evaluation of the control campaign has reduced many of the weakness and the programme is now proceeding satisfactorily. It is planned that the population at risk, now living in all known endemic areas will be covered by this programme.

(e) *Leprosy Control*—Planning for a National Control Programme was completed and the programme was launched in 1968. In the control programme, emphasis will be placed on early ambulatory treatment of the patients through an active case-finding scheme. Institutional treatment will be restricted to admission of infectious cases for a period sufficient to render the cases non-infectious and of those requiring re-constructive surgery. The Central Leprosy Registry has been established and four skin clinics have started in priority areas where the incidence of the disease is high. More skin clinics with adequately trained staff will be opened as the programme gathers momentum. This programme is being integrated with the existing medical and health services from the very out-set. The primary objective of this programme is to reduce the incidence of leprosy so that the disease will not be a public health hazard and it is estimated that this will take about 20 years.
